DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

The undersigned Mayor, or person authorized to act in his stead, of the Town of Indian Beach, North Carolina, hereby makes the following Proclamation pursuant to the Town's enabling ordinance and North Carolina General Statute Section 14-288.12.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Hurricane Isaias has the potential to impact the Town of Indian Beach. A State of Emergency is deemed to exist in the Town of Indian Beach located about the center of Bogue Banks in Carteret County.

a. There is determined to be existing or threatening a dangerous Hurricane which could result in injury or damage to persons or property or could create a clear and present danger of injury or damage to persons or property in the Town of Indian Beach;

WHEREAS, the Mayor or other authorized person acting in his stead is empowered to issue a Proclamation declaring a State of Emergency to exist and to impose such restrictions and prohibitions appropriate and necessary to meet the exigencies of the State of Emergency;


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AND PROCLAIMED THAT:

1) This State of Emergency shall take effect Sunday August 2, 2020 at 8:00 AM and shall continue from the moment of this Proclamation until such time as the storm shall end, the danger is over, and it is safe for the citizens and other persons to return to the Town of Indian Beach as is determined by the Mayor or the Town's Board of Commissioners that the State of Emergency no longer exists.

This Proclamation is issued this 2nd day of August 2020.
