



DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY HURRICANE ISAIAS

WHEREAS, Hurricane Isaias has the potential to impact Town of Cedar Point, NC; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the above-described disaster, I have determined that there is an imminent threat of, or existing conditions have caused or will cause, widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property, and public safety authorities will be unable to maintain public order or afford adequate protection for lives or property; and

WHEREAS, declaring a State of Emergency and imposing the restrictions and prohibitions ordered herein is necessary to maintain order and protect public health, safety, and welfare and to secure property.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Mayor of the Town of Cedar Point, under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Chapter 6 of the Cedar Point Code of Ordinances:

Section 1 – State of Emergency is hereby declared within the jurisdiction of the Town of Cedar Point


Section 2 – I hereby order all law enforcement officers and employees and all other emergency management personnel subject to our control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of this Declaration, all applicable local ordinances, state and federal laws.

Section 3 – I hereby order this declaration: (a) to be distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public; (b) to be filed with the Town Clerk and (c) to be distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.

Section 4 – This declaration shall take effect at 6 o'clock on August 1, 2020 and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded.
