**TOWN OF NEWPORT  
DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Hurricane Isaias has the potential to impact the Town of Newport; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the above-described disaster I have determined there is an imminent threat of, or existing conditions have caused or will cause, severe damage, injury, or loss of life, of property, and

**WHEREAS**, declaring a State of Emergency is necessary to protect public health, safety and welfare, maintain order and to secure property.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Mayor of the Town of Newport under Article 1A, Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Chapter 32, Newport Code of Ordinances, a State of Emergency has been declared to exist in the Town of Newport which is found to be as follows:

**Section 1.** A State of Emergency is hereby declared within the jurisdiction of the Town of Newport, NC.

**Section 2.** I hereby order this declaration: (a) to be distributed to media outlets and other public address forums; (b) to be filed with the Clerk to the Town of Newport and (c) to be disseminated to others for proper implementation and action of this declaration.

**Section 3.** this declaration shall take effect on SATURDAY, AUGUST 1, 2020 AT 12:00PM, and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded.
