CARTERET COUNTY ANNOUNCES CURFEW

September 5, 2019

11:00 AM

Carteret County, NC – A curfew has been set for Carteret County today, Thursday September 5, 2019. Residents located within the unincorporated areas of Carteret County are required to remain indoors from dusk to dawn.

There will be no sale, consumption, transportation, or possession of alcoholic beverages during the curfew in the County of Carteret, except possession or consumption on a person's own premises.

During the curfew, there shall be no sale or purchase of any type of firearm or ammunition, or any possession of such items along with any type of explosive off owner's own premises.

The State of Emergency for Carteret County became effective at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 3rd and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded. County officials issued the declaration ahead of Hurricane Dorian in order to more effectively protect the lives and property of the residents in Carteret County.

The curfew will remain in effect until further notice.
