Several things to pass re: Hurricane Dorian:

- The NWS in Newport has starting updating their Severe Weather briefing page on their website. This can be viewed throughout the event at <https://www.weather.gov/media/mhx/LatestBriefing.pdf>. It is updated twice a day (normally early in the AM, and around 6PM).
- The All-Volunteer PKS Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) wants to know who is in town throughout the event. Pls see the message below from CERT Leader Tom King. *Note---as of this evening no evacuation decisions have been made at the County or local levels.*

From the PKS CERT:

Attention Pine Knoll Shores residents!!!! If you plan to remain on the island during hurricane Dorian, in order to help public safety personnel expedite your status after the hurricane has passed and to provide you assistance ASAP if required, please call 252-646-6506 from 7 AM to 10 PM on Monday (September 2nd) or Tuesday and provide the contact information required. These calls days and times may be changed based upon an updated Dorian arrival time However, you can still call anytime outside these hours and after the stated ending period and provide your name and phone number on voice mail. Someone will call you to either obtain the information required or confirm that your information was received. IMPORTANT!! If you change your decision and decide to leave the island, please call 252-646-6506 and give notice of your change.

This program is not, repeat not, an incentive to remain on the island during hurricane Dorian. Remember, with a category 3 hurricane, all public safety personnel will depart the island. There will be no one from public safety to provide assistance until after the hurricane has passed and they return to the island. You will be staying on the island at your own risk.
