

Good Evening Everyone,

Reminder that a curfew began at 7PM this evening and will continue until further notice. Walking the streets to check on neighbors' homes is unsafe and is considered a curfew violation. The town will begin drive-by damage assessments as soon as is safe and practical after Dorian has passed.

Winds are expected to be very dangerous overnight and in the early morning hours. We are predicted to have winds over 90mph between 3AM and 7AM with some gusts predicted at 120mph. Even at noon tomorrow winds will be over 40mph with higher gusts. Trees in town are already weak and some trees fell earlier this evening without significant wind. **Tomorrow is NOT the time to begin cleaning up your yard!**

Tornado and storm surge risks continue to be very high. Please ensure you have the means to receive tornado warning messages during the night and seek shelter.

Sonny Cunningham and his crew have pumped down the water table in the east end of town farther than we ever have. **We are in the best position we can be for flooding concerns. We will not send Sonny out in dangerous weather to move pumps.**

I will provide an update first thing in the morning and then, as long as it is safe to do so, I will be out getting a visual assessment of the town to share with you as I did with Hurricane Florence.
