Carteret County Curfew Lifted  
September 6, 2019  
6:00 p.m.

Carteret County, NC – Carteret County issued a curfew on Thursday September 5, 2019 from dusk to dawn; ahead of Hurricane Dorian in order to more effectively protect the lives and property of the residents in Carteret County.

Effective Friday, September 6, 2019, the curfew is hereby lifted for all persons who are located within the unincorporated areas of Carteret County. There will be no curfew this evening at dusk.

With the curfew lifted, the restrictions placed on the sale, consumption, transportation and possession of alcohol and the restrictions placed on the sale or purchase of firearms and ammunition are no longer in effect.

The State of Emergency issued September 3, 2019 continues to be in effect for Carteret County residents. All civilians and emergency management personnel are ordered to continue to comply with the emergency plan.
